Ear Seed Placement - Quick Reference Guide

* The numbers correspond to ear acu-points shown below For each condition, place ear seeds on all the relevant ear acu-points on one ear Remove ear seeds after 2-4 days, and then apply a fresh set of ear seed stickers on the alternate ear We recommend doing so for one month to monitor progress

Diagnosis of Ear Pain

When the ear is not the source of the pain (secondary otalgia), the ear examination is typically normal The cause of primary otalgia is usually apparent on examination; the most com-

ENT REFERRAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- The so-called "light reflex" is not a valid indicator of ear disease - In a crying child, there may be uniform injection of the drum without infection being present - Otoscopy alone often is not capable of identifying a non-infected middle ear effusion or TM retraction

Reference Guide For Ordering CT Examinations

*For CTs with contrast, renal function tests need to be obtained within 90 days for patients with an age >60, diabetes, hypertension, a history of renal disease, or that may have possible renal dysfunction

NOTES Bandaging with Cravats (Triangular Bandages)
