Gastrointestinal Pathophysiology Notes: Dr, Glickman Morphologic Basis of Liver Disease Normal Architecture The Adult liver weighs 1400 to 1600 gm, and rests under the diaphragm, largely protected by the rib cage Although divided into lobes (right, left, caudate, quadrate) based on external contour and
