Hearing loss must have been diagnosed prior to acquiring spoken language (pre-lingual hearing loss) Hearing loss must be in the moderate to profound range This means that the applicant must have an unaided Pure-Tone Average (PTA) of 55dB or more in the better hearing ear in the speech frequencies of 500, 1000 and 2000 Hz
