Shows disk damage May be Clear, Carrier, or At Risk Can be sudden, acute, complete paralysis Can also have symptoms like those of DM Rear feet may knuckle over, dog may lose "quick reflex" in back feet (slow or not able to right foot) Mild to extreme; no deep pain occurs only with complete paralysis Improvement may occur with surgery
