Dealing with Arbitration Agreements in Nursing Home ...

Arbitration in the nursing home context has many downsides for plaintiffs Arbitration can be extremely expensive for the families of people killed by neglect, often takes away rights to meaningful discovery, deprives them of a jury trial and can be very difficult to 1meaningfully appeal Such procedures can also greatly inhibit full investigation
