Common Pediatric Medications

Usual oral dosage: children4: 4-10 mg/kg/dose every 6-8 hours children > 12 years4: 200 mg every 4-6 hours as needed (maximum 1200 mg/24 hrs) adults2: 400 mg/dose every 4-6 hours * Pediatric dosage should not exceed adult dosage DISCLAIMER: Drug information is constantly changing and is often subject to interpretation
