Differences Between Opinion, Persuasive, and Argument Writing

Persuasive writing focuses on convincing the reader to agree with the author The author uses logic and facts to persuade the reader Argument writing is used to support claims in an analysis of a topic The writer uses facts, evidence, and reasons to develop claims and opposing claims www
