The Company of Merchant Adventurers came about in the early fifteenth century, with the royal charter of 1407, giving English merchants the right to govern and organize themselves in the Low Countries (Holland, Zealand, Brabant, and Flanders) and was one of the first chartered trading companies in England (Bisson 1993:3)
