Think-aloud approach The think-aloud protocol asks participants to provide an account of what they are thinking as they respond to a survey item (the think-aloud protocol) or just after responding to the item(the retrospective protocol; Tourangeau et al, 2000) Think-aloud protocols are typically administered under standardized conditions

communication condition to the moderator's silence in the traditional think-aloud method There was a significant difference with how natural participants felt while experiencing the various protocols These findings suggest that the moderation style has a potential impact on the type of verbalizations produced

Disadvantages of the think-aloud method: Subject usually requires training in the method Subject may resist the technique Possibility for subject to stray from the topic at hand Subject may bias his/her description of his/her decision processing The verbal probing method can either be concurrent or retrospective (Willis, 1999)
