#### **Alpaca and Llama Parasite Treatment**

Alpaca and Llama Parasite Treatment Albendazole (Valbazen) 10mg/kg Do not recommend in pregnancy or for young crias! Much better for killing tapeworms than Fenbendazole Give orally - 6cc/100 pounds of body weight Give one dose once per day for three days in a row (max) May need to repeat in two weeks depending on parasite load

## **PAIN MANAGEMENT: CAMELIDS, SMALL RUMINANTS, AND ...**

Llamas and alpacas: 01 mg - 025 mg/Kg IM q 4 hours[5, 6] Fentanyl: more potent than morphine The dermal patch offers the advantage of long duration (48 - 72 hours) without the need to re-dose It should be applied to an area where the animal cannot reach to minimize risk of patch removal or ingestion The area should be clipped
